## PhD Completions 2002-03 to 2007-08 by Ethnicity

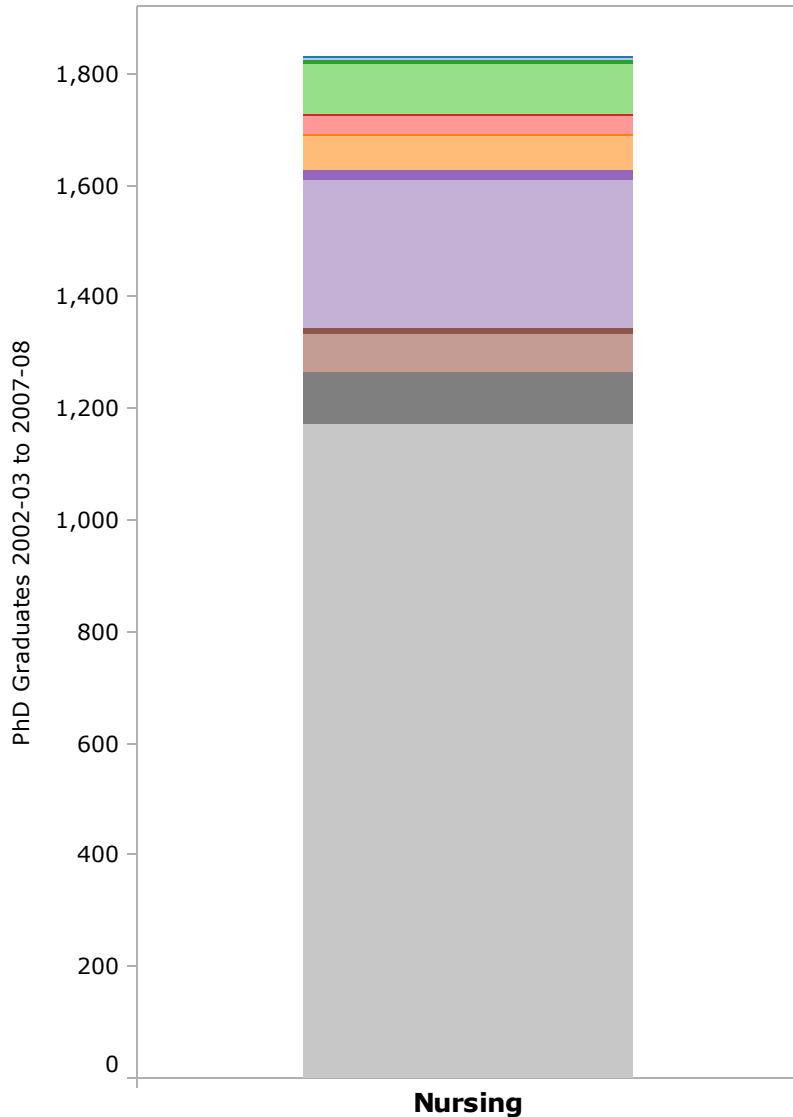
### Carnegie Classification Research Universities, Very High Research Activity
