HR/SIS Downtime: During the weekend of February 28th - March 1st, the SIS Project Team will complete its fourth Move to Production of new functionality. Please be aware that, to accommodate this installation, the Human Resources/Student Information System (HR/SIS), including all applicant and self-service pages, will be unavailable beginning Friday, February 27th, at 3 p.m. Access will be restored on Sunday, March 1, 2009, following the scheduled maintenance. For SIS users (including applicants and students), the system will be available Sunday evening, March 1, 2009, after 9:00 p.m. For HR users, the system will be available Monday morning, March 2, 2009.

As we finalize preparations for the fourth of our five planned moves to production, I would like to note how far we have come in planning, building, implementing, and utilizing the new SIS. The numbers below provide a picture of where we are today.

SIS Production by the Numbers (as of January 30, 2009):

41,742 Applications received for Summer 09 and Autumn 09

12,729 Applicants admitted for Summer 09 and Autumn 09

8,000 Acceptance Fee Statements created and sent

1,931 Applicants paid acceptance fees or indicated they are coming

299 Student Applicants for Study Abroad

269 Student Applicants paid Study Abroad application fee online

850,000 Students' biographic & demographic data converted from legacy

35,000 Unique student courses converted from legacy

102,398 Student Center user accounts created

1,571 Administrative user accounts created
