THE SIS PROJECT: SIS REQUISITE ENTRY INITIATIVE IS COMPLETE

The Requisite Entry Initiative ended Tuesday, July 15th and was a huge success! The initiative required the help of many college and department personnel to manually enter existing course requisites (or what we used to call "prerequisites") into the new Student Information System. Several training sessions and labs were conducted between February and July, 2008 to assist those doing the entering. During that time, 5482 requisites were entered and attached to courses, far exceeding expectations! The SIS Student Records application team is currently reviewing entries and preparing to move them for the conversion to the new system at the end of September 2008. In the future, the Registrar's Scheduling Office will be responsible for entering requisites and will be doing dual maintenance until October, 2008.
