**Certificate description**

Intercultural competence is one of the essential learning outcomes for college graduates. Completion of the coursework and embedded experiences of this certificate will give students the tools to identify and actively manage the interpersonal challenges of the global and diverse workplace and gain a deeper understanding of the capabilities that they develop and the practical applications in the real world.

Students must take a minimum of 4 courses to satisfy the certificate requirements. Courses used in one category may not also be used to satisfy a requirement in another category (e.g. Required Core course FRIT 3054 may NOT be used as a COIL course in the "Intercultural Enrichment" category)

**Required Core Courses (2 courses, 6 credit hours):**

- **FRIT 3054:** The 21<sup>st</sup>-Century Skill: Intercultural Competence for Global Citizenship (*GEL: Diversity-Global Studies; GEN Theme: Citizenship for a Diverse and Just World*)
- **COMM 3668:** Intercultural Communication

**Race, Ethnicity and Gender Diversity Course (1 course, 3 credit hours)**

- Choose **one** 2000-level or above course from the GEN Foundation: Race, Ethnicity, and Gender Diversity category.

**Intercultural Enrichment course(s) (1-2 courses, 4-8 credit hours)****Choose one of the following three options:**

- Take **one** Education Abroad or COIL (Collaborative Online International Learning) course that is approved as GEN Themes course with a High Impact Practice: Global and Intercultural Learning: Abroad, Away, or Virtual (4 credit hours).
- OR-**
- Take **one** 3-credit hour Education Abroad or COIL (Collaborative Online International Learning) course **AND one** additional 2000-level or above course from the GEN Foundation: Race, Ethnicity, and Gender Diversity category (6 credit hours).
- OR-**
- Take **two** courses approved as a part of the GEN World Language category or a one-semester 5 credit hour intensive world language course, such as Italian 5101 (5-8 credit hours).

**Certificate Program Guidelines****Credit hours required:**

- A minimum of 13 credit hours

**Overlap with courses in degree:**

- The certificate must be in a different subject than the major.
- Max 100% overlap with courses in a major, minor, other certificate, or GE.

**Grades required:**

- Minimum C- for a course to be counted on the certificate.
- Minimum of 2.0 cumulative GPA for all certificate course work.

**X193 credits:**

- Not permitted.

**Approval required:**

- The certificate course work must be approved by a college/school advisor.
- Students may declare the Certificate with their primary academic advisor.

**Consult with Program Advisor:**

- For filing deadlines.
- For changes or exceptions to a certificate plan.
