## MS/MPH Dual Degree Program Minor Revision

**Description:** The Master of Science in Dentistry/Master of Public Health Dual Degree program was created in 2021 by the Colleges of Dentistry and Public Health to prepare dentists to address social, economic, and environmental causes of unmet oral health care needs of adults and children. As of August 2024, 3 pediatric dentists have earned both degrees. Two of them are practicing in rural communities and/or treating largely Medicaid populations outside of Ohio. One alumnus will be starting a faculty position at Ohio State. Two pediatric dental residents (i.e., students) are currently enrolled in the program.

# **Summary of Changes and Rationale:**

Master of Science in Dentistry Curriculum

As a result of its continual self-evaluation and quality improvement process, one course (DENT 8712) has been added, one course (DENT 8711) has been split and is taught across two academic terms, two courses (DENT 8710 and DENT 8151) have been removed. In addition, the credit hours for two courses (DENT 8706 and DENT 8999) have changed.

Added DENT 8712 Simulation in Pediatric Dentistry to better prepare residents for medical emergencies and other patient care scenarios.

Split DENT 8711 Management of a Contemporary Dental Practice into two parts, one taught in autumn semester and one taught in spring semester of the second year to better match when residents are applying for jobs and preparing to enter practice. The total number of credits required for this course decreased from 2 to 1.

Removed DENT 8710 Oral Pathology, which was taught every other year in summer term to both firstand second-year students as the instructor left the university. The material is now taught in other courses.

Removed DENT 8151 Moderate Sedation from autumn semester of the second-year. Residents were enrolled in this course in autumn semester 2020 as it was offered asynchronously online but the content was not relevant for pediatric dentists so residents are no longer enrolled in this course.

Increased the credit hours of DENT 8706 Oral Facial Injury and Emergency Care in autumn semester of the first-year from 0.5 to 1.5 credit hours to align with the course contact time.

Increased the credit hours of DENT 8999 Research from 1 to 1.5 credit hours in spring semester of year 1 to match the time residents are allotted for their research projects.

### Master of Public Health Curriculum

Moved start of courses from summer term to autumn semester of the first year because the other master's programs start in autumn semester. This change in start allows alignment of recruitment efforts for all master's programs in the College of Public Health.

This resulted in the following changes.

PUBHLTH 6615 Leadership in Public Health and Health Care moved from summer term of first year to summer term of second year.

PUBHHMP 6630 Project Management moved from summer term of first year to summer term of third year.

PUBHHMP 7632 Strategic Change for Healthcare and Public Health moved from summer term of second year to spring semester of third year.

PHR 5402 Economic Evaluation of Healthcare Interventions moved from autumn semester of second year to spring semester of the second year. This course was cross-listed as PHR 5402/ NUR 7402. The College of Nursing cancelled its course so it's only listed through PHR but the content and format of the course is the same.

PUBHHMP 7683 Operations Management and Systems Design moved from spring semester of second year to autumn semester of second year.

Credits required to earn the Individual MS Degree: Was 67 hours and now 66.5 hours.

Credits required to earn the Individual MPH Degree: Remains at 42 hours.

**Total Minimum credits required for students to fulfill both degree requirements:** Was 94 hours and now 93.5 hours.

The current students will stay on the current curriculum plan and new students will follow the new plan.
