RE: INFORMATIONAL ITEM: **Dual License in Primary Education and Intervention Specialist BS program**, Department of Educational Studies and Department of Teaching and Learning.

Please find materials included in this proposal related to a small-scale revision of the Dual License in Primary Education and Intervention Specialist BS program.

The department proposes:

- Reducing EDUTL 5195.01 from 4 credits to 2 credits
- Increasing ESSPED 4191.02 from 8 credits to 10 credits

These changes account for 0% of change, as the overall credit hours remain the same for the program. This was approved by the EHE Curriculum Committee on December 12, 2024.

Re: Approval of dual license credit hour change for SPED P5 Program

Dear Dr. Miller,

The Educational Studies Undergraduate Studies Curriculum Committee received an update for the Special Education Primary Dual Licensure program. The update summarized the changes made in the placement of student teaching as follows:

- Primary student teaching moves from SP26 to AU25 and remains at 8 hours, while seminar decreases from 4 to 2 hours. **Net decrease is 2 hours.**
- SPED student teaching moves from AU25 to AU26 and increases from 8 to 10 hours with a <u>net</u> increase of 2 hours.

Although this was considered a non-voting item, the committee was made aware of the change and approved it to move forward in the curricular approval process. Please let me know if you need any additional information.


