Located in the scenic rolling hills of east central Ohio and led by Dean and Director William L. MacDonald, The Ohio State University at Newark resides on a beautiful, 225-acre campus with 134 acres of green space. The institution was founded in 1957, with classes held in the early years at the old Newark High School. The first building on campus, Founders Hall, opened in 1968. Thanks to an incredibly generous local community, the campus has outstanding facilities and approximately \$1 million in annual aid and scholarships in 2019-2020 as well as \$1 million in Affordability Grants to support a diverse and active student body.

Coming from all over Ohio, students at Ohio State Newark receive outstanding instruction from a first-rate faculty that in recent years has received funding from the National Science Foundation, the National Endowment for the Humanities, the Ohio Arts Council, the Ohio Humanities Council, the Ohio Department of Education and several private organizations. Ohio State Newark shares its campus, facilities, and many staff members with Central Ohio Technical College. The partnership creates money-saving efficiencies and allows both institutions to offer student life experiences and educational opportunities that neither institution could offer on its own.
