Penny, the FRM Program Area faculty met this week and request the following changes to the current Consumer Affairs minor to correct a typo and bring the requirements in line with changes in nomenclature;

Change name to Consumer Services Minor (Cons Serv, 119)

The minor in Consumer Services consists of a minimum of 23 credit hours. The minor is designed to enable students to understand the consumer/market relationship, with special emphasis on identification and solution of consumer problems. Students must take Consumer Sciences 340 and Family Resource Management 243 and 443, as well as two other graded courses in Consumer Sciences or Consumer Sciences: Family Resource Management.
