

Dear Ed,

The administration for the Graduate Interdisciplinary Specialization in Engineering Management (ISEM) program is currently the responsibility of the Department of Integrated System Engineering, specifically the Industrial and Systems Engineering Graduate Studies Committee. The graduate faculty of the Industrial and Systems Engineering program have considered the conversion of the ISEM program to semesters, and a vote has been conducted to decide whether or not to withdraw the program.

The vote of the faculty regarding whether or not to retain and convert the ISEM program to semesters or to withdraw the program was 11 votes in favor of withdrawal, and 0 votes in favor of retention and conversion.

Per the outcome of the vote, the ISE faculty has decided to withdraw the ISEM program.
