Rationale:

Please accept for consideration our proposal for the deactivation of the Master of Architectural Studies program. As we transition to semesters, the KSA has been exploring the development of undergraduate and graduate level minors, so our attention and resources are devoted to these efforts. We feel that the high-quality minors will prove to reach a wider audience than the MAS program without increasing our staffing demands. Deactivation is requested immediately as the program has not been advertised and, therefore, we have not received applicants.

Impact:

We currently have no students in the program so no one will be impacted by the deactivation; no transition plan is needed. Should the Architecture Section of the KSA hire additional faculty in the future, we may consider the program's reactivation. If you have any questions, I would be happy to address them.
