Proposed Transcript Abbreviation: BIOE

Rationale: Three new Bioethics programs are being created: (1) an Undergraduate Minor (which was approved 3/4/15); (2) a Master of Arts program that is in development; (3) a Graduate Minor program that will parallel the proposed MA. Seventeen new courses will be created as a result.

In addition to these new/proposed programs, there are four undergraduate Bioethics courses and four graduate Bioethics courses that are currently approved and active. To date, these eight courses in bioethics have been listed under the Biomedical Sciences Graduate Program (BSGP) Subject Area, and yet the intent has always been for these courses to be eventually listed under a specific bioethics call number/transcript abbreviation (ie, BIOE). The Center for Bioethics has noted that it is difficult for current students to locate these existing courses via the registrar, and having a Bioethics Subject Area for these would aid navigation as well as possibly increase enrollment.
