RE: ADDITION OF REGIONAL CAMPUSES AND CHANGE OF DELIVERY: COMPUTER/TECHNOLOGY ENDORSEMENT

The faculty and administration of the College of Education and Human Ecology (EHE) approve of adding the Computer/Technology Endorsement on the Marion, Mansfield, Lima, and Newark campuses and for the endorsement to be deliverable 100% online from the Department of Educational Studies. The proposal was approved by the EHE Curriculum Committee and is supported by Educator Preparation.

Included with this request is the department's letter and the endorsement curriculum sheet. The Computer/Technology Endorsement consists of 4 graduate level courses, with a minimum of 12 credit hours required. EHE and Marion, Mansfield, Lima, and Newark campuses have entered into a cost sharing agreement MOU to allow for students to enroll through each campus. The MOU has been signed by all campuses and is in effect. Allowing for enrollment at Columbus, Marion, Mansfield, Lima, and Newark allows for local districts outside of Columbus to utilize school district fee waivers, which has not been possible previously.

EHE approves of adding the Computer/Technology Endorsement on the Marion, Mansfield, Lima, and Newark campuses and for the endorsement to be deliverable 100% online from the Department of Educational Studies. and requests approval from the Council on Academic Affairs.
