#### College Credit Plus

College Credit Plus replaced Post Secondary Enrollment Options Program in autumn 2015.

- Open to qualified students in grades 7 12
- Dual Enrollment students earn both high school and college credit
- Emphasis on student choice
  - K-12 school must allow students to participate if they are admitted to a college or university
  - Students must be treated the same as degree seeking students
- Free of charge to student and family
  - High Schools cover costs of tuition (reduced) and books
  - Colleges accept lowered tuition and waive all fees

#### Statewide Data -

- Increases in dual enrollment across Ohio
  - 2014 30,000 students participated in PSEOP
  - 2015 52,000 students participated in CCP
  - 2016 65,000 students participated in CCP
    - Includes Summer 2016 10% of students enrolled during summer
- Students can take classes on college campus, online, or at the high school

#### Statewide data

- Participation by grade level
  - 70% of CCP students in grades 11 or 12
  - 114 7<sup>th</sup> graders and 351 8<sup>th</sup> graders participated in 2016/17
- Student Success
  - 90% of students earned credit (D or higher)
  - 3% had failing grades, 2% withdrew past the deadline,
    3% no grades reported, 2% other
- 65% of students who participated in CCP in 2015-16 matriculated to an Ohio public IHE.


#### **CCP Participation at OSU**

    - ODEE partnerships with College Ready Ohio Program




#### Academy Enrollment AU13 – AU17

#### HB 49 – Changes to CCP

The Governor's budget included several provisions on College Credit Plus

- Assessment
  - All students must be assessed for College Readiness
  - Specific eligibility requirements are standard for all colleges and universities
  - Institutions of Higher Education required to pay for student assessment
- ODE/ODHE will set policies for Course Eligibility and Under-Performing Students
