Dear Dr. Smith,

The College of Food, Agricultural, and Environmental Sciences is requesting Council on Academic Affairs approval for a revision to the Agribusiness - AS program offered at Ohio State ATI as outlined in the attached document. We are requesting that these changes be made effective Autumn 2020. The proposed change – removing MATH 1131 and adding AEDECON 3105, as well as increasing credits available as electives – aligns this program with the proposed changes to the Agribusiness and Applied Economics BS degree program in the Department of Agricultural, Environmental, and Development Economics (pending with CAA). As a result of these proposed changes, there is an overall change from 61 to 61-62 credits required to complete the major.

This proposal has been approved by the Academic Affairs Committee of Ohio State ATI and by the College Academic Affairs Committee. Please let me know if any additional information is needed in support of this request.

Dear Ms. Osborne,

Enclosed please find the proposed revision to the curriculum plan and course sequence for the Associate of Science Agribusiness program submitted for consideration by the FAES Academic Affairs Committee.

The proposed revisions to the Associate of Science Agribusiness program were developed by the program coordinator, Kim Hostetler, in consultation with other faculty involved in the program and in the Department of Agricultural, Environmental and Development Economics. A major course and an elective course were added, and a Math course was removed. The overall credits for the degree changed from 61 to 61-62. This curricular change aligns the Associate of Science Agribusiness program to the Bachelor of Science Agribusiness and Applied Economics program. Ms. Hostetler provided the following rationale for the curricular change:

The Department of Agricultural, Environmental, and Development Economics proposed changes to the Bachelor of Science Agribusiness and Applied Economics program, effective AU20. To stay in alignment, the following changes to the Associate of Science Agribusiness curriculum are proposed.

- **Remove MATH 1131 Calculus for Business as required course:**
MATH 1131 was removed from the Bachelor of Science program, changing the mathematical preparation required to College Algebra rather than Calculus. To keep in alignment, the course was removed from the Associate of Science program.
- **Add AEDECON 3105 Principles of Agribusiness and Food Supply Chains as a requirement:**
AEDECON 3105 is a new major course in the Bachelor of Science curriculum. Wooster was added as a campus of offering, allowing the course to be added to the Associate of Science curriculum and keeping the programs in alignment.

- **Add 2–3 credit hours of elective:**

In order to achieve the 60-credit hour minimum for the Associate of Science curriculum, the balance of the credit hours was moved to an elective course of 2-3 credit hours.

- AEDECON 3141 Agricultural Cooperatives (2 credits) fulfills a required major elective in the Bachelor of Science curriculum.
- AEDECON 3000 Quantitative Methods in Agribusiness and Applied Economics (3 credits) fulfills a major requirement in the Bachelor of Science curriculum.
- BUSTEC 2240T Introduction to Project Management (3 credits) fulfills a required major elective in the Bachelor of Science curriculum.
- ECON 2002.01 Principles of Macroeconomics (3 credits) fulfills the open option requirement in Bachelor of Science curriculum.

The proposed changes to the current curriculum plan and course sequence for the Associate of Science Agribusiness program were approved by the Arts, Science, and Business Division at Ohio State ATI and the Ohio State ATI Academic Affairs committee. Ohio State ATI is committed to protecting the academic progress of students. This program change will not disrupt progress toward degree for students enrolled in this degree program. Course substitutions and manual management of the degree audits will occur as needed for students enrolled in this degree program during the transition. When appropriate, coursework completed by students under the current degree program will be utilized for completion of the proposed degree program.
