Dear Randy,

I write to inform you that three centers will be created within academic units in the College of Arts and Sciences. These centers will remain within units and are not freestanding centers that report to the college.

As a result of securing Good to Great grants the following two centers will be created: 1) Germanic Languages and Literatures will establish the Umwelt Center for Germanic Studies & Environmental Humanities, and 2) Women's, Gender, and Sexuality Studies will establish a center for Feminist Research, Education & Engagement (FREE Center).

Also, the Center for Languages, Literatures, and Cultures will establish a center for American Sign Language and Deaf Equity in order to consolidate efforts around teaching ASL, training future instructors of ASL, and credentialing current instructors of ASL.

These Centers will be evaluated on an ongoing, regular basis by the college.
