As I mentioned last week, we have some changes to make to our embedded literacies due to changes in the structure of the courses (e.g., removal and/or addition of writing assignments, etc.). We would like to make these changes **effective Spring 2024**. These changes are to all three degrees (BA in Political Science; BS in Political Science; BA in World Politics).
