Please accept this notice of change to the existing and formerly approved BSPH/MPH combined degree programs in the College of Public Health. The change is a result of the Ohio Department of Higher Education decision to limit the number of credit hours that can overlap between a combined Bachelor's and Master's Degree. The College of Public Health revised their combined degree programs with this new decision and attached are curriculum guides reflecting the changes.
