I write to request a change in the curriculum for the MA and PhD programs in Theatre. We would like reduce the required 8995 Proseminar class from 1 credit/semester, repeated 2 times to 1 credit/semester, taken only once. Based on student feedback on the courses, and petitions to be excused from the second semester, we realize that a single semester of Proseminar provides students with adequate base preparation to fulfill the professional requirements of a career in Theatre Studies. Further preparation is best pursued at the individual level, with guidance from the academic advisor.

We intend for this change to take effect immediately. Current students who have not yet completed the second Proseminar credit hour will be able to choose between completing the course a second time or opting for another elective. Total credit hours required for the MA and PhD in Theatre will remain the same.
