

Overview of OSU Regional Campuses

- The Ohio State University isn't just a single campus in Columbus. As a land-grant university, Ohio State has a physical presence throughout the state, with campuses and research centers located around Ohio.
- There are four OSU Regional Campuses. They are located at: Lima, Marion, Mansfield, and Newark and have a combined enrollment of approximately 5,900 students.
- These four Regional Campuses help Ohioans realize their full potential through affordable access to education and research, thereby driving the next generation of development, growth, and productivity for Ohio's economy.
- Students at the OSU Regional Campuses benefit from small class sizes, individualized attention with award-winning faculty members, and the breadth and reputation of an Ohio State education.
- The OSU Regional Campuses prepare students for today's workforce and/or to continue their education. They are challenged to think critically and creatively through cross-disciplinary learning. Science, technology, engineering, arts and math courses are integral in sparking innovation.
- The OSU Regional Campuses serve as a gateway to hundreds of OSU degrees—including engineering, environmental studies, and a wide range of health-related majors.
- Each of the four OSU Regional Campuses are led administratively by a campus dean/director.
- Each of the four institutions have an Advisory Board comprised of nine local community members and one student who meet regularly with the dean/director of the campus. The board members are appointed by the Executive Vice President and Provost in consultation with the dean/director of each regional campus and serve without monetary compensation.
- Each of the four OSU Regional Campuses share services such as libraries, safety, physical facilities, etc. with a co-located state technical college partner.
- The four OSU Regional Campuses collectively generated \$5 million in savings through shared services with their co-located institutions in 2016.
- Combined enrollment at these four regional institutions: 5,900 (AU 17)
- Combined total expenditures at these four regional institutions: \$63.7 million (FY 16)
- Combined acreage of these four regional institutions: 1,616 acres
